- Conveys wastewater to North City Water Reclamation Plant (WRP)
- Supports Phase 1 purified water and recycled water production
- Trenchless construction will be used to avoid:
  - environmentally sensitive areas
  - freeway crossings

- Founded in 1990 and currently has more than 2,500 employees
- Recent projects: Miramar Clearwell Improvements and North City Pure Water Reclamation Plant Early Site Works
- Key components of North City Pure Water Facility project:
  - Production capacity of 34 million gallons per day of purified water
  - 32.8 million gallons per day capacity booster conveyance Pump Station
  - Pump Station has four 1,000 horsepower vertical turbine pumps

## **Morena Northern Pipeline & Tunnels**

- Two pipelines will start at Genesee/SR-52 and continue through UC to the NCWRP
  - One transports wastewater to the NCWRP (N)
  - One transports brine from the NCPWF to PLWTP (S)
- Three short tunnels (approx. 1,000 ft. long) at SR-52, Rose Canyon (Genesee), and I-805
- Morena alignment will also go through
  Clairemont and Bay Park/Morena communities

## SD What You Can Expect

- "Block by block" road closures to through traffic; detours will be posted
  - Access for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles will be maintained; some delays expected
- Construction equipment and material staging areas along the alignment; staging areas will move along with construction
- Possible intersection closures due to weekend work
- Posted detours for bike lanes, sidewalks and trails
- No parking in construction zones
- Impacts such as noise, dust, bright lights and construction vehicle traffic during work hours







- Over 100 years of history and more than 2,000 employees
- West Coast operations were established in 2013
- Similar projects: Newhope Project and Mission Trails Project
- Key Components of the Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project:
  - Approximately 20,874 linear feet of 48-inch wastewater force main and 30-inch Brine centrate conveyance pipeline
  - Shaft and tunnel work at I-805, Marian Bear Memorial Park and Genesee overpass
