






## **CPU Subcommittee Meeting - Mobility**

#### **Pedestrian**:

• Genesee Avenue and La Jolla Village Drive need pedestrian features to improve walking conditions along the corridors.

#### Bicycle:

- Half of the responses identify the need to improve intersections along Genesee Avenue.
- 77% stated connections across Interstate 5 (I-5) are critical.





## OVERVIEW OF MOBILITY ACTIVITY RESPONSES

#### Transit:

• Genesee Avenue received the most indications for needing transit improvements.

#### **Roadways**:

- Roundabouts were the most selected feature; along Governor Drive.
- La Jolla Village Drive, North Torrey Pines Road and Genesee Avenue were identified as the most congested roadway segments.
- Genesee Avenue and Governor Drive as the most congested intersection.






