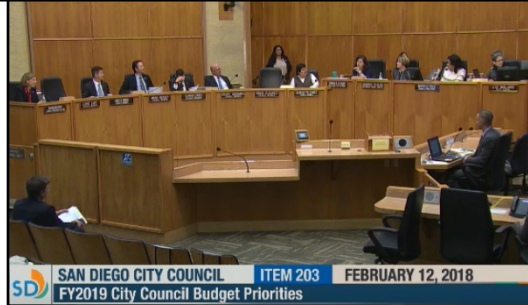

On Monday, February 12th, my Council colleagues and I unanimously approved the **Fiscal Year 2019 City Council Budget Priorities Resolution**.

- 📍 **Youth Employment Programs in San Diego:** Do you know a youth between the ages of 17-24 who is looking for work? YouthBuild and CareerSmart, two free and federally-funded programs, are accepting enrollments in their paid job training programs. Youth receive paid training, a certificate in technology or construction, and are connected to employment after training ends. Those without high school diplomas can receive their diploma during the program with specialized classes facilitated by the San Diego County Office of Education. Bus passes are provided to students for transportation to and from the training site.
