Concerns from Customers about High Water Bills

The City of San Diego Investigates the Cause of the Problem





The Public Utilities Department has seen an uptick in concerns from customers receiving higher-than-normal water bills and my office has received a number of calls regarding this issue.

For over a month, residents across the San Diego region have received water bills with rates in the thousands.

The department did an internal review of customers throughout the city of San Diego and found over 300 meters had been misread due to human error. The average overcharge for affected single-family residential customers was \$303, with some higher or lower depending on water usage during the billing period.

Currently, an audit of the City's Public Utilities Department is underway to review water billing practices and confirm whether the billing inaccuracies were a one-time occurrence.

The audit will focus on customer billing issues and review PUD's data acquisitions and billing procedures for the period of July 1, 2016 through January 31, 2018. The City Auditor, Eduardo Luna plans to complete the audit by this spring.

- Youth Employment Programs in San Diego: Do you know a youth between the ages of 17-24 who is looking for work? YouthBuild and CareerSmart, two free and federally-funded programs, are accepting enrollments in their paid job training programs.
