Council President Myrtle Cole's Special City Council Meeting on Homelessness

Select Committee on Homelessness Underway



On Monday, March 20th, I organized a **Special City Council Meeting to address homelessness**. I assembled this meeting because **homelessness looks different in each of our neighborhoods**, but at the end of the day, it's clear that we have too many people living unsheltered in our city, and we needed to do more to address this issue. With hundreds of community residents and several organizations in attendance, we listened to a variety of voices to discuss current and future solutions regarding homelessness in San Diego.

My City Colleagues and I heard informational presentations from **San Diego State University, the Mayor's Office, the County of San Diego, and the Housing Commission**. They detailed current efforts and future actions to significantly address homelessness, including **enhanced efforts to provide transitional and permanent supportive housing**.

We heard from many organizations and individuals, and what was clear was that we must **increase the number of permanent supportive homes for individuals and families who need extra help to get back on their feet**.

Moving forward, I have placed an item on the **April 5th Rules Committee** agenda which will create a **Select Committee on Homelessness** that will be composed of four City councilmembers. The direction for the Select Committee on Homelessness will be to discuss and revisit city policies regarding homelessness, funding mechanisms to address our homeless, and other related issues the committee feels appropriate to discuss.

I look forward to continuing the work with the San Diego City Council and our regional partners to **further address our homeless populations' most urgent and long-term needs**.
