## Councilmembers Cole and Gloria Pushes State to Fund Prop 47 | \$100 Million Toward Services for Ex-Offenders

The San Diego City Council approved a resolution asking the State of California to increase funding for Proposition 47 programs in the 2016-2017 State Budget. Councilmembers Cole and Gloria pushed to make \$100 million more available statewide for programs addressing mental illness, substance abuse, dropout prevention, and victim services.

Now, the resolution adopted by the Council will be sent to the Governor, Speaker of the Assembly, Senate President Pro Tem, members of the Assembly Committee on Budget, and members of the Senate Budget and Fiscal Review Committee to be considered as they complete the 2016-2017 State Budget.

## Illegal Marijuana Dispensaries Enforcement | Several Dispensaries Shut Down in D4

The Code Enforcement Division gave a report to the Public Safety and Livable Neighborhoods Committee Meeting last week for a marijuana dispensary enforcement update. Councilmember Cole requested an update on this issue because she was concerned that illegal dispensaries were not being closed down.

Notices of Violation would often include structural, electrical, and mechanical modifications to commercial spaces constructed without the required permits and inspection removals. Out of all of the citywide marijuana dispensary closures, four were shut down in District 4. It is critical to continue to close down illegal dispensaries quickly and most effectively to prevent easy access to the youth.

## Broadway Heights Banner District | "In the Heart of the Neighborhood"

The San Diego City Council approved a resolution to establish and authorize the Broadway Heights Banner District to allow the installment of street banners in the public right-of-way to promote cultural and civic events, and other community activities.

The Broadway Heights Community Council will be able to install banners stating, "Home of the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway" at several locations throughout their community.

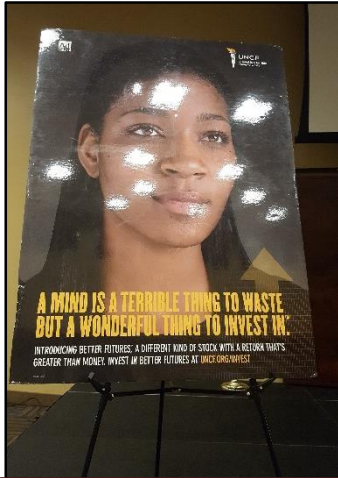
