

Budget Hearings for the FY 2017 Budget | The Fight for the Paradise Hills/Bay Terrace Senior Center

For nearly three decades, the Bay Terraces Filipino-American Seniors Association has gathered at the Bay Terraces Community Park, affectionately known as Tooma Park, to engage in daily activities including dancing and socializing, building camaraderie and a community. Today, the group has well over 300 members.

In the 1990s, the association requested assistance with building a senior center. The City was able to provide a concrete foundation and a few shade structures within the park. At that time, a permanent senior center facility was also promised to the community. This budget season, I am fighting hard to fulfill that promise.

The seniors continue to wait patiently, trying not to lose hope and dignity. I have included in my budget priorities a request for \$2.1 million to construct the long-awaited senior center facility and have urged the Mayor and my Council colleagues to support the project as well.

I'd like to thank all of the residents and supporters who have joined me in this fight to ensure that our voices are heard and that the Fourth Council District receives no less than any other community in our city.

Additional Budget Priorities for District 4

In addition to the senior center, I am also advocating for (to name a few):

- increased personnel to ensure the timely hiring of public safety and dispatch professionals;
- improvements to various parks, including the Encanto Recreation Center, Marie Widman Park, MLK Recreation Center, Emerald Hills Park;
- the expansion of homeless outreach programs to address the growing population in our canyons and neighborhoods;
- outside legal counsel to ensure the independence of the Citizens Review Board (CRB) on Police Practices;
- and funding for a Disparity Study to ensure that there is equal opportunity and fairness in all aspects of city contracting.

Lastly, I invite you all to once again participate and comment on the Mayor's proposed budget. The next scheduled public hearing is on Monday, May 16, 2016 at 6:00pm in Council Chambers—202 C Street, 12th Floor.

National Football League Foundation Grassroots Program Grants Up to \$250,000 for Projects: The goal of the NFL Foundation Grassroots Program is to provide non-profit, neighborhood-based organizations with financial and technical assistance to improve the quality, safety, and accessibility of local football fields. Proposals are due on August 15, 2016. Strong preferences will be given to proposals that:

- ✚ Seek to upgrade existing facilities that are in poor condition
- ✚ Demonstrate active use of the fields
- ✚ Attract matching funding that exceeds the minimum required match of 1:1
- ✚ Involve local partnerships with non-profit community partners
- ✚ Provide for continuing maintenance and field safety
- ✚ Involve youth football programs that are currently registered and in live with USA Football Heads Up Football safety initiatives
