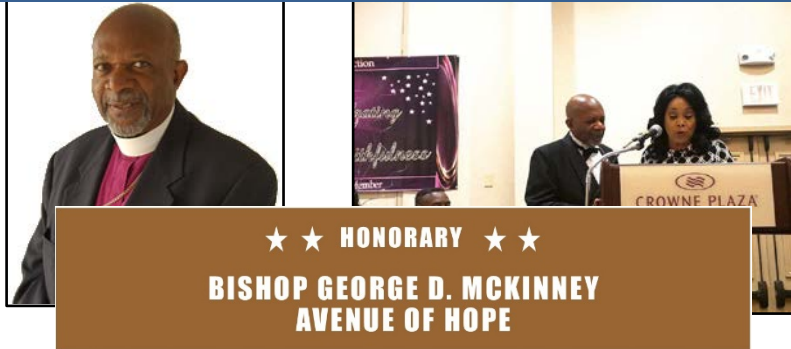

Second Honorary Street Name Designation in CD4 for Bishop George D. McKinney on Imperial Avenue



On Tuesday, May 15th, the City Council unanimously passed the resolution to recognize **Bishop George D. McKinney as my second honorary street name designation in Council District 4.**

The honorary street sign will be located on the block of **5825 Imperial Avenue between the intersections of Valencia Parkway and Gannet Street** in the Valencia Park community.

Bishop McKinney is the Founder and Pastor of **St. Stephen's Cathedral Church of God in Christ** which he founded in 1962. For over 55 years, Bishop McKinney has transformed countless of lives through his leadership at St. Stephen's and continues to motivate residents to improve their lives and surroundings by helping their neighbors.

He is also a former probation officer, a renowned licensed marriage, family, and child counselor, as well as an author of eight books. **I cannot think of anyone more deserving of this designation.**

Port of San Diego Summer PAID Student Worker Program

-  This program was created to help teens and young adults learn and develop on-the-job skills that can be used for entry level positions. In addition to learning about the different departments within the Port, students will learn how to interact with customers, use office equipment and other skills associated with the different disciplines within the Port.
-  You must sign up in person at the Port of San Diego Building, **3165 Pacific Highway, San Diego, CA 92101, starting at 2:00 p.m. on June 2, 2018.** A lottery drawing will be held at 2:30 p.m. and you must be present if your name is drawn.
 - Please bring a state or school ID to the lottery. Students will be asked to complete a placement card, eligibility for employment form, tax forms, and attend a brief orientation.
-  Minimum Qualifications:
 - Must be between the ages 16 and 21 on the day of the lottery
 - Must have been a full-time student in the spring of 2018
 - Must be able to work a minimum of four (4) hours and up to eight (8) hours per day, Monday through Thursday 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.
-  The Summer Student Worker employment period is from **July 2, 2018 until August 30, 2018.** The hourly rate of a Summer Student Worker is **\$11.54.**

T.A.A.P. Teen Alcohol Awareness Program

-  This program is designed to address the questions that your new high school driver asks when they are ready to hit the road. What happens when they drive? Who is responsible for their actions? The teen drivers will spend time with their parent(s) in a classroom environment lead by the San Diego Police Officers, then the teens will be released to go to the DUI Checkpoint.
