NETWORK. OUTREACH. EDUCATE.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- **Youth Emergency Readiness Ambassadors (YERAs)** will outreach to hard-to-reach youth populations in San Diego County to increase their awareness about emergency preparedness.
- Emergency preparedness includes how to prepare for events like wildfires and earthquakes, as well as health emergencies like COVID-19.
- With the guidance of an Emergency Preparedness Expert, YERAs will work as a team to develop outreach materials, create an outreach plan, and implement their plan to educate San Diego youth.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicants must be between the ages of 16 and 22 years old.
- If selected, appointment is conditional upon successful completion of background evaluation.
- Applicants must provide a letter of recommendation from a community organization, with whom the applicant is affiliated.
- If selected, applicants under 18 must provide a signed parent/guardian agreement.
