## Summary

Citywide Trust (67) was stable without change compared to February. Among the 9 Divisions the most significant change in Trust scores was a 3-point drop in Northern (67) and a 2-point increase in Western (67). Citywide Safety (70) was up by 1 point compared to February with a 6-point increase in Southern (72).

Citywide, the top concern was Homelessness (25%) followed by Streets & Traffic (23%) and Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins (20%).

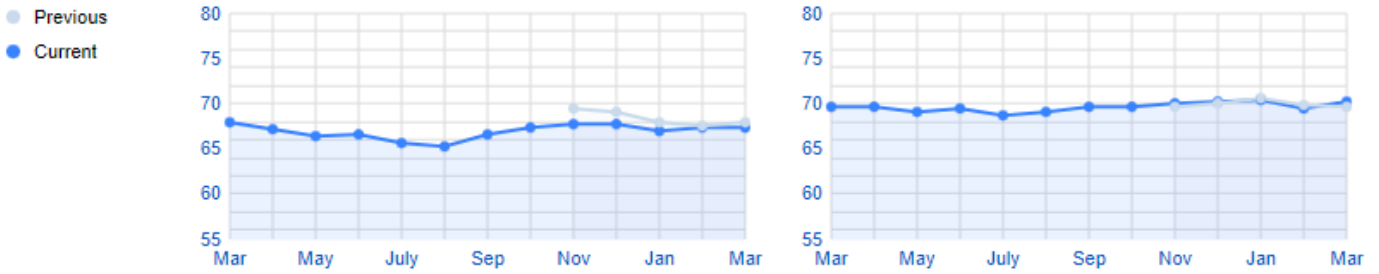

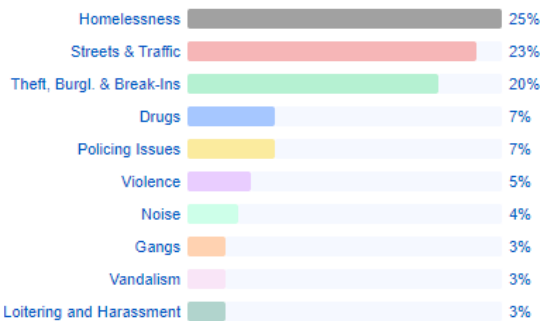
### Trust Heatmap

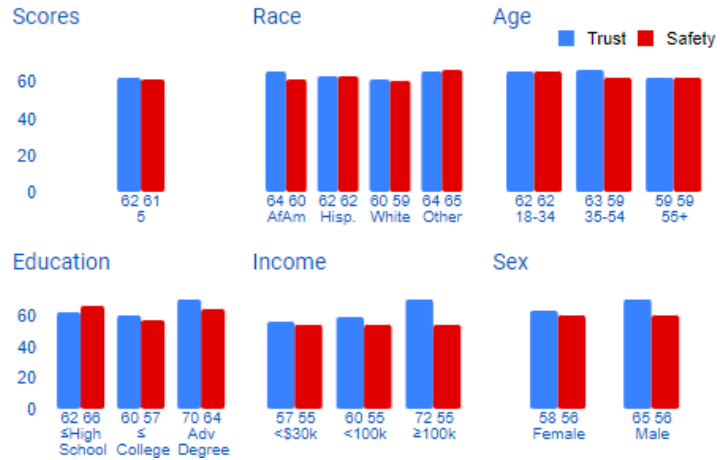

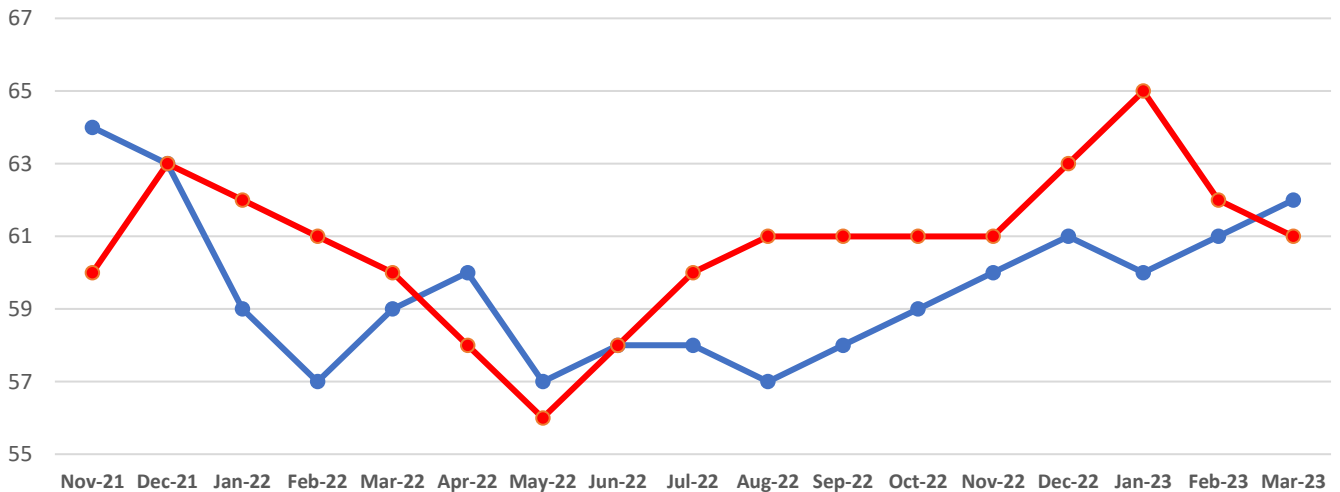
Trust for the Central Division was up by 1 point compared to the previous month (62). Safety for the Division was down by 1 point compared to the previous month (61).

Homelessness remained the main concern for the Division (51%), followed by Theft, Burglaries and Break-Ins (13%) and Drugs (10%).

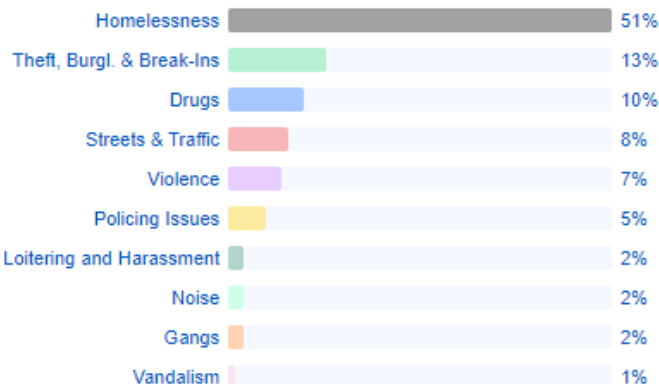
