Summary

Citywide Trust (67) was up by 2-points compared to August. Among the 9 Divisions the most significant change in Trust scores was a substantial 5-point increase in Northwestern (74) and a 4-point increase in Northeastern (71). Citywide Safety (70) was up by 1-point compared to August with a 3point increase in Northwestern (78) and a 2-point increase in Northeastern (73).

Citywide, the top concern was Homelessness (23%) followed by Streets & Traffic (22%) and Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins (19%).
