



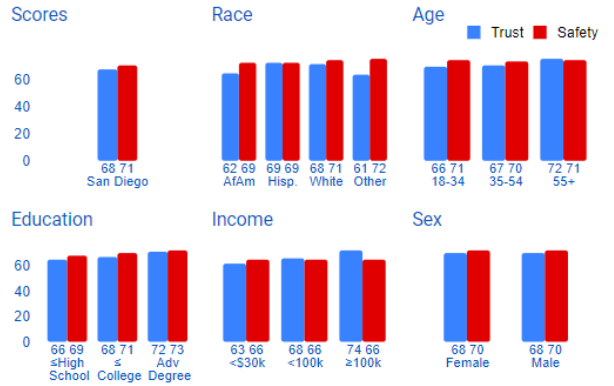

## Summary

Citywide Trust (68) was down by 1 point compared to August. Among the 9 Divisions the most significant changes in Trust scores were 3-point drops in Eastern (68) and in Southern (68). Citywide Safety (71) was stable without change compared to August with a 3-point increase in Central (63).

Citywide, the top concern was Homelessness (23%) followed by Streets & Traffic (21%) and Theft, Burglaries & Break-Ins (20%).

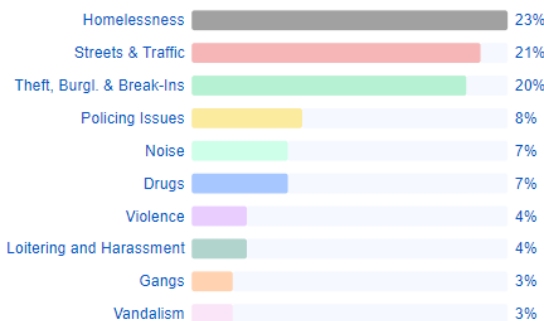
### Trust Heatmap

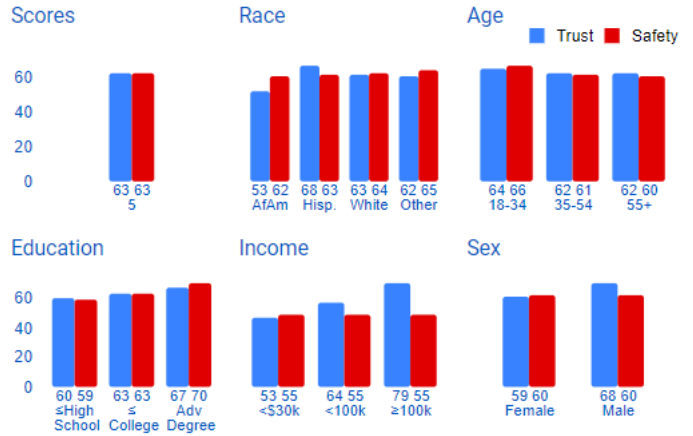

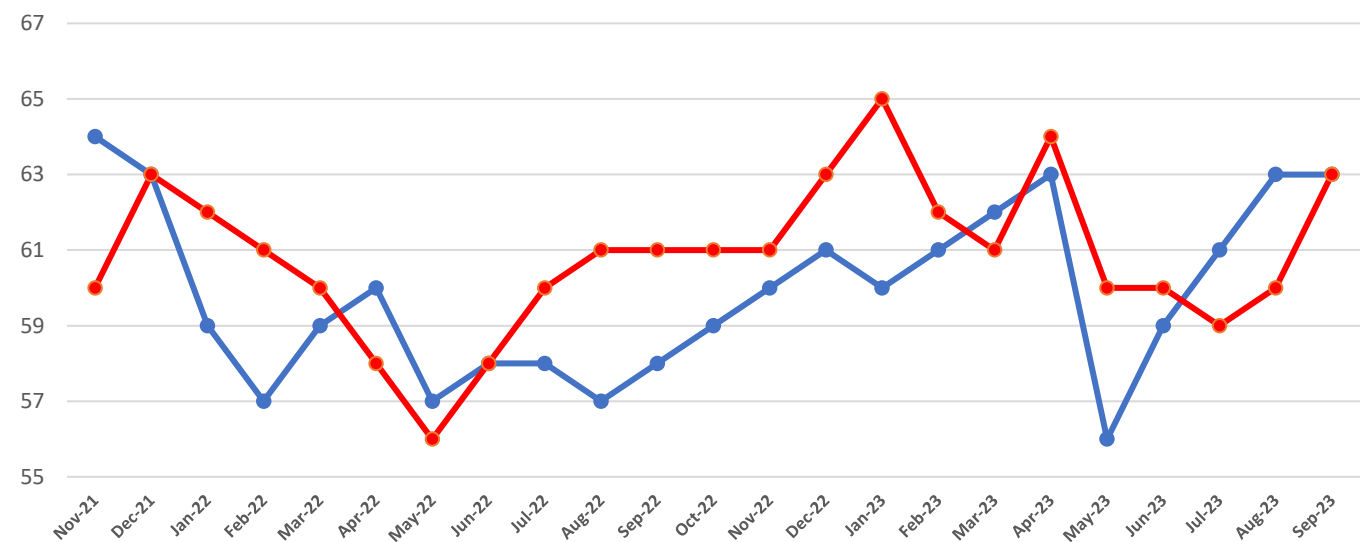
Trust for the Central Division was stable without change compared to the previous month (63). Safety for the Division was up by 3 points compared to the previous month (63).

Homelessness remained the main concern for the Division (46%), followed by Streets & Traffic (13%).

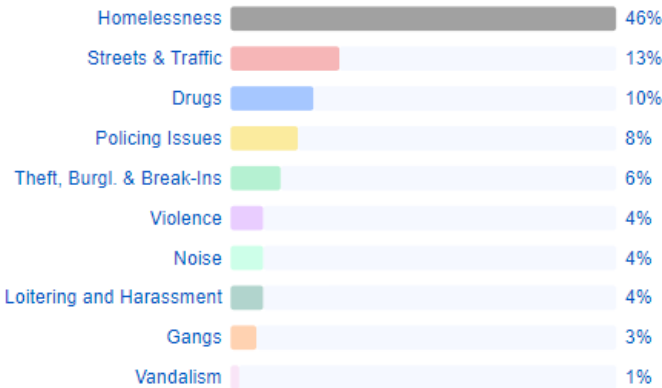
### Score Benchmark Chart
