Auto and Household Waste Recycling Event Coming to Mira Mesa

SAN DIEGO TO COLLECT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE AND USED AUTO PRODUCTS ON APRIL 7

SAN DIEGO – Residents are invited to drop off their household hazardous waste on Saturday, April 7 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at San Diego Miramar College. The City of San Diego’s Environmental Services Department (ESD) Household Hazardous Waste Program will be offering a free community recycling event in cooperation with the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle). Residents are asked to bring their household hazardous waste to the corner of Black Mountain Road and Miramar College Driveway (West Lot 2 is on the western side of Miramar College parking lot). Business waste will not be accepted.

“Residents are encouraged to bring their used motor oil, oil filters, household batteries, fluorescent bulbs and antifreeze to this free community event,” said ESD Program Manager, Joy Newman. “These free events are held throughout the year to prevent household hazardous waste from making it into the City’s storm drains and landfills.”

WHAT: Used Auto Product and Household Hazardous Waste Recycling Event

WHO: City of San Diego, ESD Household Hazardous Waste Program
 Residents of the City of San Diego

WHEN: Saturday, April 7, 2018, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

WHERE: San Diego Miramar College (West Lot 2)
 Corner of Black Mountain Road and Miramar College Driveway
 San Diego, CA 92126

NOTE: Items accepted include used and contaminated motor oil, oil filters, auto batteries and antifreeze. Also accepted are fluorescent bulbs and household batteries. No business waste will be accepted, but some local retailers (AutoZone, Firestone, and O'Reilly) accept used oil and oil filters.

In addition to the April 7 recycling event, the City has several curbside cleanups [scheduled](#) in neighborhoods across the City where residents can leave out large items for pickup:

- Saturday, April 7: Mount Hope
- Saturday, April 21: Linda Vista
- Saturday, May 5: Clairemont East
- Saturday, June 2: Mira Mesa
